Barony of Stichel created beginning of 13th century or earlier

Barony of Galashiels created in 1597

07/08/2014

1. A charter incorporates the whole into the free barony of Galashiels and anew erects the town of Galashiels into a free burgh of barony
2. Dand succeeded his father or grandfather, William, as constable of Cessford Castle
3. In Dec 1510 at the Justice Ayre, Jedburgh, David in Tynnes was surety for Dand for wrongfully occupying Hounam Common without a lease
4. Only William, Alexander and David were involved with Teviotdale and Ettrick Forest. Of the three only William held lands in Midlothian and Peeblesshire
5. David, 2nd of Smailholm, acted as attorney at the sasine of Willian de Gordon in the lands of Stichill [Stichill Writs]
6. Torwoodlee and Toftnes were in the hands of David in Tynnes before they passed to William, first of Torwoodlee
7. On 10 Apr 1510 David in Tynnes assigned Tynnes and Glengabir to William of Torwoodlee (MSS. Torwoodlee)
8. Dates relate to appearance in the records
9. It was Robert 1st of Smailholm that married Elspeth Dishington - she built Old Gala House for her son David
